


# Grade Two News

## June 2019



We can't believe June is already here! The school year has flown by. We have a few very busy weeks ahead. Please check your **child's agenda** and the **REMIND app** for important updates. We are looking forward to several special days in June: field trips, swimming, picnics, and sports day. Thank you in advance to parents who are able to volunteer on our special days. Our **Telus World of Science field trip, Edmonton, AB, will be on Friday June 21. Please note we will be leaving school promptly at 8:30 am and arriving back at 4:00 pm, PLEASE make arrangements to have your child picked up at that time as we will not return in time for buses.** Our students will be participating in a Bike Rodeo on the afternoon of June 12, more information to follow.

We will be completing several final assessments in all core subjects.

Language: We will be completing our research projects on **Bugs**, during the first part of June. For the remainder of June, students will be writing about memories in grade 2, swimming and the rodeo, as well as continuing to improve their reading skills.

Math: Students will be **reviewing** all the **grade two math outcomes**. Students will be completing a final grade 2 math assessment, reviewing all outcomes. A copy of the assessment will be in your child's portfolio, we will also share a copy of this assessment with your child's grade 3 teacher.

Science We will be finishing up our **Small Crawling and Flying Insects Unit** in the month of June. We will also be participating in an exciting bug hunt at the Centennial Park.

Social: We will continue our study of **'connecting to the past'** for the remainder of the school year. Students will focus on appreciating how stories of the past connect individuals and communities to the present, as well as appreciate the importance of collaboration and living in harmony. Our field trip to **Reynold's Museum in Wetaskiwin, on June 13**, will be our culminating activity for this unit.

Gym: Grade 2 run, jump, throw **sports event will take place** on the morning of **June 11**. Students will enjoy participating in a variety of fitness related activities outside. Please ensure your child is **appropriately dressed for being outdoors and active (running shoes are a must!)**
