
Grade Two News - April 2019



We hope everyone had a restful and enjoyable spring break. It's hard to believe we only have 3 months left of the school year. April will be an exciting month. We have a special performance on <u>April 8th</u>, Alberta opera will present the play Pinocchio. <u>Language</u>: Students are continuing to improve their reading skills with small group and partner reading activities. **Continued practice, at home, reading will further develop your child's literacy skills.** Students are continuing to work on improving their writing skills through fiction and non-fiction writing.

<u>Math</u>: We will continue with our study of **two digit addition and subtraction**, as well as practicing **measurement** skills. We will continue to practice problem solving to develop students ability to apply their math skills. **Keep working, at home, on basic addition and subtraction facts to 18.**

<u>Science:</u> Our theme on "Hot and Cold Temperature" is a good fit for April. We will track the changes in temperature outside and discuss how temperature changes affect people and animals. We have lots of fun experiments in the weeks ahead!

<u>Social</u>: We are continuing to learn about **Saskatoon, Saskatchewan; learning about the prairie culture.** Students had the opportunity to try perogies, part of the Ukrainian culture in Saskatoon. We also learned the art of pysanky egg design and are continuing to learn about the natural resources in Saskatchewan.

During the month of June our students will enjoy TWO exciting field trips. The first will be June 13 to Reynold's Museum in Wetaskiwin. The 2nd trip will be to the <u>Telus World of</u> <u>Science in Edmonton, AB on Friday June. 21.</u> We will also enjoy a fun swim on Wed. June 26 from 1-2pm.
