



Grade Two News- December 2017

In Language:: All students are working on developing their reading and writing skills. We will continue to work on learning vowel combinations and consonant blends in spelling/ word work and reading. Home reading is an excellent way to practice your child's reading abilities. Please listen to your child read 10–15 minutes a night or read to them for 10 – 15 minutes.

"Reading aloud is widely recognized as the single most important activity leading to language development. Among other things, reading aloud builds word-sound awareness in children, a potent predictor of reading success."

In Math: Students are working on solving problems using a graph (data analysis) and developing students understanding of equality and inequality, using addition and subtraction equations Students are developing their fluency with adding facts to 10. By the end of grade two students must be able to mentally (without manipulatives) add and subtract numbers to and from 10. For extra math practice please have your child choose a math site from our webpage, pesgrade2.weebly.com, under 'helpful sites'.

In Science: Mrs. Allen's class is currently working on hot and cold temperature. Mrs. Abt's class are learning about boats and buoyancy. Mrs. Wessner's students are currently learning about Magnets.

In Social: All three classes are enjoying learning about the geography, climate and culture of the Inuit culture in Iqaluit, Nunavut. Students are learning about the similarities and differences between students in Iqaluit and students in Ponoka. We will continue to learn about the interesting traditions in the Inuit culture.

In Music: (Mrs. Abt)

We are practicing our songs and dances for the upcoming Christmas concert. Our theme this year is a tour through the 3 social studies communities (Iqaluit, NU, Meteghan, NS, Ponoka, AB)

<u>Dec. 22</u> The last day prior to Christmas break students will participate in a fun 'Polar Express' theme day. Students are invited to wear their PJ's for the day. We will participate in a variety of math and language activities connected to the story 'Polar Express'. Mrs. Wessner's class will be supplying extra lunch snacks for all the grade 2 classes (please watch for a note in your child's agenda). Thank you to Mrs. Abt's class who donated delicious and nutritious snacks for our Halloween lunch. Mrs. Allen's class will be asked to bring lunch snacks for our Valentine's lunch in February.




Christmas Concert




Winter weather has arrived!
