February was a busy month filled with skating, Valentine's day fun and our school talent show.. We were very proud of our grade 2 students talent show performance, well done Mrs. Abt and all grade two students.

We will enjoy our last skating day on Friday March 2. Please ensure your child brings their skates, helmet, snow pants and milts. Please take the time to review basic addition and subtraction facts (adding and subtracting to and from 18) to improve your child's ability in this area. Students will also start working on measurement using non-standard units.

<u>Science Ms. Allen's</u> class is finishing up the unit on Boats and Buoyancy. Students will be creating a boat on their own. Please watch for an information package to be coming home soon. <u>Mrs. Wessner's</u> class will complete their study of Hot and Cold temperature the last week of Feb., first part of March. We will begin Boats and Buoyancy for the remainder of the month.

In <u>Mrs. Abt's room,</u> we are finishing up the exciting topic of magnetism and the kids will be working on designing, and building a toy or game that includes magnets.
