February was a busy month filled with skating, Valentine's day fun and our school talent show.. Students will continue working on their reading and writing skills in language arts. We are learning about two digit subtraction in math, a sometimes tricky concept in grade two. Please work with your child to ensure they are able to easily solve addition and subtraction facts to 18 to further their understanding of two digit addition and subtraction.

March 1st is the 100th day of school, students will enjoy fun 100 day math activities.

Language: Students in all four classes are continuing to develop their reading and writing skills. Please continue home reading to further develop your child's accuracy, comprehension and fluency.

Math: Students are continuing to learn **two digit addition and subtraction**. Our grade 2 website pesgrade2.weebly.com has a variety of online games to help your child with adding and subtracting skills. Students will also start working on **measurement** using non-standard units.

Science Our next interesting science topic is "Hot and Cold Temperatures". Students will learn about thermometers and how they work, observe changes in energy of different materials, and learn how humans and animals adapt to very cold and very hot environments.

Social We are continuing our study of the culture of Saskatoon SK (Ukrainian settlers and First Nations). Students enjoyed sampling bannock and creating a teepee as we learned about the First Nations culture in Saskatchewan. During our study of Ukrainian students will enjoy designing their own pysanky egg and sampling Ukrainian foods.

Gym We will participate in balances, leaps and rotations in our Gymnastics Unit this month. We will resume having outdoor gym time on Wednesdays in March. Please remind your child to dress for the cold weather or the wet weather, whichever one we have each week.
