

Grade 2 Halloween Fun at PES

To celebrate Halloween on Tuesday, October 31, the grade 2 students will enjoy a day of fun activities.



Students are welcome to wear their costumes to school for the day. We ask that costumes be school and age appropriate (nothing too scary please). We do not allow toy weapons—please keep guns, swords, knives, at home. Please do not send any face paints, makeup, hair sprays to school as we don't allow the kids to apply these items at school. The children may bring a mask, but they will be asked to remove their mask during instructional/ learning times.

During our morning LA and Math periods, we will participate in curriculum activities with Halloween themes. In the afternoon, we have the special opportunity to watch the the play "Monsters Under the Bed" being performed by our community theater group. We will be walking to the United Church for the play, as outlined in the consent forms previously sent home.

As a special treat, we will share a grade two party lunch. For Halloween, Mrs. Abt's class will be on snack duty. Each of Mrs. Abt's students will bring a snack to be shared with all our grade two friends. (There are 64 students in total) It is important that our snacks be in line with our school goals of healthy eating, we hope the kids will bring fruit, veggies, cheese and crackers, yogurt, and other nutritious choices. Due to the common occurrences of nut allergies, we ask that snacks do not contain nuts.

Each child will still need to bring one "main" lunch item (sandwich, wrap, pizza etc) to go with the party snacks.

Finally, we'd appreciate your help in limiting the amount of candy and sweets your child eats for the rest of the week. Please do not allow them to bring much of their candy to school. We will not allow the children to eat any candy at morning snack, and will limit them at lunch time also.
