

# Grade Two News October 2018 

Hard to believe we are in month number two of grade two. Students have worked hard to demonstrate an understanding of 'above the line' behaviors at school (using appropriate manners and following rules). We are pleased with students effort and progress. Please remember our day begins at $8: 30 \mathrm{am}$, it is very important your child arrives on time to ensure they dont miss important learning opportunities.. If you have not aready done so, please send headphones with your child as we use them for listen to reading and computer projects. Students also require a water bottle to help them stay hydrated throughout the day.
School picture day will be on October 10th and 1th.

## Language:

We will continue working on building our stamina during Daily 5 literacy activities (read to self, read to someone, word work, work on writing and listen to reading). Students are enioying working on their reading and writing stamina. Students will begin working on our grade 2 spelling program, Words Their Way. Students will be grouped into four groups to allow us to best meet each child's academic needs.

Home reading will begin this month. Please watch for the home reading bag (book and recording sheet). Students will be awarded a prize for every 25 nights of reading. We ask that you please spend $10-15 \mathrm{~min}$ per night listening to your child read, to further enhance their accuracy and fluency skills. Thank you for your continued support.
Book orders will be sent home in October. Due dates for book orders will be written in student agendas.

## Math:

We are continuing to work on patterns. Each child will be identifying, reproducing, extending and creating repeating, increasing and decreasing patterns. We are also working on our number sense unit, students are learning to break apart numbers and find all the ways to make ten.

## Science:

We will be continuing with our unit on Exploring Liquids. The kids are enioying getting their hands wet while doing lots of experiments. There are lots of opportunnties to identify and observe liquids at home; you can ask your child to compare different liquids and explain their properties. Coming up this month, we will also learn about the water cycle and the importance of water in our lives.

## Social:

Students worked hard to remember the location of the 4 communities, from our first social unit. The four focus communities in grade two social studies are:: Ponoka, AB/ Saskatoon, SK/ Meteghan, NS, and lgaluit, NT. We have started our first exciting journey to lgaluit, Nunavut. Please ask your child about lgaluit and all the exciting learning adventures.
