Working with younger students is fantastic because we have the opportunity to watch their skills and abilities grow by leaps and bounds. We are excited to have the opportunity to meet all of our students and their families, to begin our terrific learning adventure together. We want our classrooms to be positive, engaging places where we care and respect each other, and take responsibility as enthusiastic learners. Our classes will participate together in many special activities throughout the year. It creates a positive environment as students interact with their friends and teachers/staff. We create a unique sense of community. The grade two team does not view the students as "mine" or "yours" but instead we consider them ALL of "our" students!

We'd like to begin our year by establishing positive, open communication between the school and home. We feel very strongly that as teachers and families, we need to work together to support children as they grow and learn. The school agenda will be used each day to keep students organized, to inform you about important items or upcoming events, and to send home notices. Please look at your child's agenda each evening and initial it to let us know that is has been checked. You may write any notes or place papers to be returned to school in the front pocket. Agendas will be checked by the homeroom teacher each morning. Please feel free to contact your child's homeroom teacher anytime during the year, through a note, phone call, or email if you have questions or concerns about your child. Each homeroom teacher will help facilitate communication with other team members.

In our efforts to keep class sizes as small as possible for Language Arts and Math, we are fortunate to be able to run four homeroom classes in the morning. After lunch, it is necessary for us to create three learning groups. Most of the students will remain with their original morning grouping all day. The children from Mrs. Johansen Hornett's morning class will be assigned to one of the other three afternoon homerooms. Our grade team decided upon this routine because we realize the importance of maximizing teacher/student contact. We feel this schedule will allow us to provide effective support for all students, especially in the critical areas of literacy and numeracy. If you have questions or require more clarification, please feel free to contact us.

Grade two students will enter and exit the school using the North-east entrance, and this is where we'd like you to drop off and pick-up (meet) your son/daughter. We appreciate parents waiting outside the doors for pick-ups. Please avoid coming into the school and walking through the learning communities, as this is distracting to the students and teachers. It is very important that you inform us of changes to usual home-time plans by writing a note in your child's agenda. We do not change the students' hometime plans without written notice.

Your child's school supplies will be ready for them at school, but please supply your child with a set of headphones. Headphones are prefered over earbuds. Thanks!

Our morning periods will be largely spent on Language Arts and Math, so it is important for the children to be on time and well rested each day. Instructional time begins immediately at 8:30. We encourage the students to have a <u>nutritious morning snack</u> at 9:50 am, prior to our literacy intervention period. Please pack or help your child choose a healthy and relatively quick/easy snack. Cookies, candy, or other sugary snacks and drinks are not allowed at this time. We do not have a water fountain in the room, so your child is welcome to bring his/her own water bottle.

Students will EAT LUNCH PRIOR to going outside to play. The bell to begin eating rings at 12:00. After eating their lunch, children will go out for fresh air and exercise, 12:20 - 12:40 pm.
